Security:

Please be very vigilant when parking and do not leave any valuables in your car, even in your boot. We are always aware of car jammimg, but the first few weeks of the year, or any term, are generally worse.

We are in constant contact with our security service providers and have requested increased patrols and visibility over this period.

We have installed more cameras as part of ongoing improvements to our security. We are also investigating the impact of cameras in the classroom and have initiated a pilot project. Cameras have been fitted in the Grade 6 classrooms. We will monitor the impact of this and determine whether it would be beneficial to roll this out over a period of time.

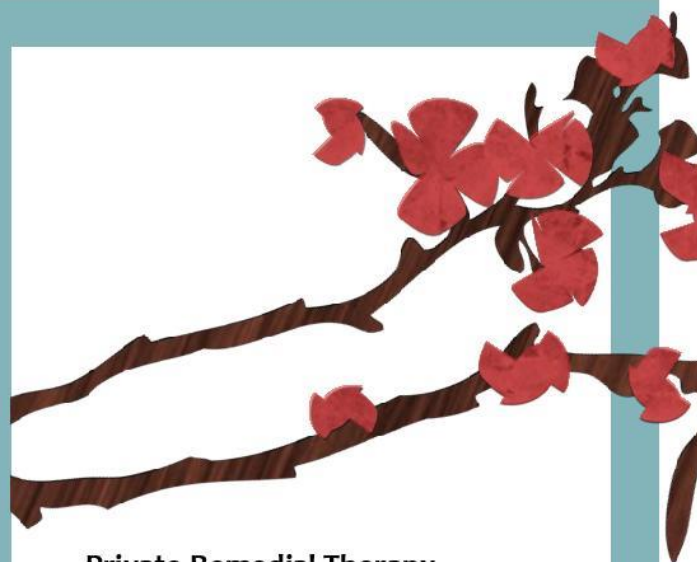
